Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are all well and keeping safe during these uncertain times?

At All Saints we have been planning what school will provide for you and your child if you have to self-isolate for 14 days.

We have considered what our provision will look like in different scenarios:-

## Scenario 1:

Child is absent because they are waiting test results and the household is required to self-isolate.

Staff will upload a weekly time-table on See-Saw and Facebook (Pre-School) that will list daily activities that need completing and returning to school once isolation has finished.

- The time-table will include links to sourced websites and assigned tasks will be allocated on Bug Club and Purple Mash. We have attached an example for you to look at.
- Live zoom sessions will be included in the time-table for Phonics and CLIC sessions. Your child will be an active participant and there is an expectation that they will log into these sessions.

## Scenario 2:

The whole bubble is not permitted to attend school because someone in the bubble has tested positive for COVID 19.

**OR,** The whole school is required to close.

- A time-table will include links to sourced websites and assigned tasks will be allocated on Bug Club and Purple Mash. We have attached an example for you to look at.
- More live Zoom sessions will be included in the time table. Your child will be an active participant and there is an expectation that they will log into these sessions.

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We understand that not all children have access to computers. In the event of having to self-isolate can let your child's teacher know. We can print resources to send home. Children will be sent a blank exercise book and pencil so that all of their work can be completed in one place – although some of their work may be produced electronically. If any further stationary is required, please contact school and arrangements will be made for these to be provided. We will be asking for the workbooks to be returned to school for marking and feedback at the end of the isolation period.
